### **Meadow Suite**

The Meadow Suite is our main function space and is located within the historic Park House on the main Whiteknights Campus.

The Meadow Suite seats up to 100 guests on the upper level with the lower level left clear for the catering to be set up. From the lower level of the Meadow Suite, you will find large doors, that open onto the decking area providing a a great outside space with views leading down to the lake.

A large private bar is available within the Meadow Suite with all the beverages you would expect including an extensive range of locally sourced products.

Three large screens are available for you to use for any photo slideshow you wish to play. Microphones are also available and included in the rate for you to use as well as the ability to play music from a Bluetooth device.

#### Meadow Suite room hire charges:

#### Monday to Friday £300 + VAT (£360 including VAT) Plus a minimum food spend of £300 + VAT (£360 including VAT).

The hire charge includes access to the Meadow Suite for 4 hours between 10am and 6pm. To open the bar, there is a separate minimum spend of £150 + VAT (£180 including VAT), subject to availability. Guests can also visit the Park House bar if this bar is not available or you decide not to have it.

If you are organising further out than a month away, the hire rate for the Meadow Suite may change as this is our reduced rate for celebration of life events which are normally only organised with less than a months notice.













### **Blandford's**

Also situated in Park House is the Blandford's dining room and the Blandford's Ante Room. These rooms have an elegant ambience and are ideal for up to 30-40 guests.

With its blend of contemporary style and classic heritage, Blandford's and the Blandford's Ante Room are perfect for a smaller wake if a private bar is not required.

You will have access to the main Blandford's Room as well as the Blandford's Ante Room. We would usually set up the catering in the Ante Room with guests in the Blandford's room.

We can leave tables as shown in the image to the left or we can move tables to the edge of the room to give more room for standing. The max we can seat in this room is 30. A TV screen to show a photo slideshow can be provided in the room for you at no extra cost.

The Park House bar is just next door for drinks from 12..00. Your event coordinator will be able to confirm the opening times of the Park House Bar.

Blandford's room hire charges:

#### Monday to Friday £200 + VAT (£240 including VAT) Plus a minimum food spend of £250+ VAT (£300 including VAT).

The hire charge includes access to the Blandford's Room for 4 hours between 10am and 6pm.

If you are organising further out than a month away, the hire rate for Blandford's may change as this is our reduced rate for wakes which are normally only organised with less than a months notice.

### **Great Hall**

The Great Hall is available when you require a very large venue to host a wake or celebration of life.

The Great Hall is located in the heart of our London Road campus. The building is a beautiful Grade 2 listed building which was opened in 1905. The hall has a fixed stage and can accommodate up to 500 guests.

We have a grand piano which can be used but it does need tuning each use which needs to be paid for by yourselves prior to arrival. You are also able to use the organ in the Great Hall as part of the hire rate.

There is no AV (including a sound system/microphones) in the Great Hall as standard but we can contract our AV team to supply a range of equipment. Please note additional charges will apply.

There is parking for up to 200 people on the London Road Campus where the Great Hall is situated. This cannot be reserved and is on a first come first served basis. We can reserve a few spaces for close family members.

#### Great Hall hire charges:

We have two rates for hiring the Great Hall. For up to 350 seats: £1,210 For up to 500 seats: £1,870

#### Plus a minimum food spend of £400 + VAT (£480 including VAT).

Depending what we have booked in the Great Hall already, we may be able to offer a discount on the above rates if the set up remains the same as what we already have booked in.

The Great Hall is not vatable so there would not be any VAT to pay on top of the hall hire rates. VAT is payable for other parts of the booking.

The hire charge includes access to the building from 9am until 10pm.

### **Q&As**

#### What is a wake?

A wake is a celebration of life event that generally happens after the formal funeral proceedings have taken place where friends and family can gather to remember the life of your loved one.

#### How to organise a wake

A wake does not need to be elaborate. A wake, or funeral reception is a more informal chance to pay your respects to someone who has died.

#### 1. Choose who to invite

A wake can be a private gathering for close family or a public gathering for the wider community. You need to consider who to invite before making other arrangements such as choosing the venue or organising food and drink. Guests that were unable to attend the funeral, may choose to attend the wake.

#### 2. Choose a venue

The wake can be held anywhere you want, but keep in mind how many people will be attending. The Venue Reading Team can help you decide on the best venue based on your expected numbers. Complimentary parking is available for guests in the main University Car Park (car park 1a). You can park even closer if spaces are available.

#### 3. Share details of the wake with family and friends

You will need to share details of where the wake is being held and at what time with family and friends. Some people prefer the wake to be private. If you choose to go down this route, you can send out invitations or ask close family members to spread the word. You may also choose for the wake to be announced at the end of the funeral service.

#### 4. Funeral wake ideas: what do you do at a wake?

It may seem strange to think about providing entertainment at a wake, and you don't have to. However, it can help to bring people together to share memories of the person who has died. Here are a few ideas:

A memory book or board – ask people to write a memory.

**Show a photo slideshow** - you could prepare a slideshow of photos. We can help you display this in the room.

**Create a background music playlist** – you could create a playlist of your loved one's favourite songs.





## **Dietary Information**

We understand the serious risks concerning food safety and allergies and to help us manage this, we do not allow any external catering in any of our campus venues. Our in-house catering team offer a full range of food and drink for your event.
